RE: **Amendment to Interconnection Agreement** of American Cellular Corporation and Dobson Communications Corporation with Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri

Dear Secretary:

American Cellular Corporation and Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc., herewith submit the attached Amendment to Interconnection Agreement By and Between Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri and American Cellular Corporation and Dobson Communications Corporation, which amends the agreement approved by the Commission in Case No. TK-2002-1056. This Amendment addresses reciprocal compensation for ISP-Bound Traffic and Federal Telecommunications Act Section 251(b)(5) traffic. The parties to the Amendment are the same as the parties to the original agreement, despite differences in their names, corporate identities or business structures, as explained in the next two paragraphs.

As stated in footnote 1 to the Application for Approval of Interconnection Agreement filed in TK-2002-1056, "Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc. is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Dobson Communications Corporation. Dobson Communications Corporation, whose name appears on the interconnection agreement along with joint applicant American Cellular Corporation, has executed this multi-state agreement explicitly on behalf of its operating subsidiaries, which in Missouri is Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc." This relationship between Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc., and Dobson Communications Corporation remains today, and this amendment to the interconnection agreement is entered into by the same entity as entered the original agreement.

As stated in footnote 1 to the attached Amendment to Interconnection Agreement, "On December 30, 2001, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (a Missouri Corporation) was merged with and into Southwestern Bell Texas, Inc. (a Texas corporation) and, pursuant to Texas law, was converted to Southwestern Bell Telephone, L. P., a Texas limited partnership. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. is now doing business in Missouri as SBC Missouri. "

In addition, it has come to our attention that the original Agreement for Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation by and between Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc., and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, which was approved by the Commission in Case No. TO-98-235, is still on file and physically shelved in the Commission's Data Center. This agreement was superseded by the agreement approved in TK-2004-1056, and can be cancelled and removed from the Commission's files.
