MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

COMES NOW Spectra Communications Group, LLC (“Spectra”), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.160, and respectfully seeks clarification of the Commission’s Order Approving Interconnection Agreement (“Order”) entered in this matter on May 1, 2003. In support of its Motion, Spectra states as follows:

1. The Commission’s Order provides in Ordered Paragraph 1: “That the Interconnection Agreement between Spectra Communications Group, LLC and WWC License LLC, filed on February 27, 2003, is approved.” The Order further provides that it shall become effective on May 11, 2003, and that this case may be closed on May 12, 2003.

2. In the course of Staff’s review of the subject Interconnection Agreement, Spectra and WWC agreed to revised language to be substituted in the Agreement and, in fact, Spectra filed a Notice of Submission of Revised Pages of Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement (“Notice”) in this matter on April 24, 2003. On that same date, and in response to the Notice, Staff filed its Staff Recommendation recommending Commission approval of the Interconnection Agreement. Paragraph 5 of the Staff Recommendation provides: “The Staff recommends that the Commission order Spectra and Western Wireless to file a complete copy of

the reciprocal compensation and interconnection agreement, with the pages numbered seriatim, that includes the revised pages.” (emphasis added.)

3. Accordingly, Spectra requests that the Commission clarify its previous Order Approving Interconnection Agreement to indicate that the Interconnection Agreement between Spectra and WWC License LLC, filed on February 27, 2003 and as revised on April 24, 2003, is approved. Spectra further respectfully suggests that the Commission order Spectra and Western Wireless to file a complete copy of the reciprocal compensation and interconnection agreement, with the pages numbered seriatim, that includes the revised pages, within ten (10) days of its Order of Clarification.

4. Spectra is authorized to state that the Commission Staff is aware of, and supports the relief requested in, this Motion for Clarification.
