Dear Secretary of the Commission:

Attached, pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission's") Order Extending Filing Deadline and Amending Interconnection Agreement by Interlineations,¹ is the successor Interconnection Agreement to the Missouri 271 Agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri and MCIImetro Access Transmission Services LLC. The parties have worked diligently to conform the Agreement in compliance with the Commission's July 11, 2005 Arbitration Order in this case but have been unable to reach conforming language on the following issues:

will each be filing a single brief by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 4, 2005 outlining their respective positions on these issues.


