ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

On June 27, 2006, the Commission issued its Final Commission Decision in this matter. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-36.050(1) requires that the parties file an interconnection agreement, reflecting the Commission's decision, within seven days after the Commission issues its decision. On July 5, the parties filed a motion for an extension of time to file the interconnection agreement. In the motion, the parties state that they expect to be able to file an interconnection agreement by August 18.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3) allows the Commission to extend the time by which the parties must file the interconnection agreement. The Commission has reviewed the motion and, finding it reasonable, will grant the requested relief.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Interconnection Agreements is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on July 6, 2006.
